THE CRITICAL TIME LIMIT FOR BRINGING CLAIMS AGAINST AN ESTATE

In the recent Supreme Court case of *Robbins v Hume* [2015] VSC 128 Justice McMillan dismissed an application to extend the time for making an estate claim. The decision highlights the importance of seeking immediate legal advice and making a claim within the statutory time limit, namely 6 months from the grant of probate.
